3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

- Identify help requirements and draw up an assistance plan with and for the client
- Assist, support and attend to people in all age groups in need of care on the basis of far-reaching pedagogical, psychological and medical care competence
- Theoretically based planning, execution and evaluation of person, age and task related support and care processes
- Assist people with care needs in their self-determination and inclusion processes
- Coordination of support systems for people with care needs within the respective social area (case management)
- Advise and support family members of people with care requirements
- Apply and coordinate pedagogical care support concepts
- Select and use medical care products and devices in accordance with professional care standards
- Cooperate with other skilled workers and those active in support an care
- Shape and manage communication processes with the assistance of negotiating and conflict management instruments
- Lead and coordinate work and communication processes in interdisciplinary teams
- Apply well-founded business and legal knowledge in designing of remedial therapy activity
- Support and coordination of structural and conceptual developments within the respective work or organisational unit
- Accord due consideration to basic legal principles relevant to the occupation in providing assistance, support and care and in dealing with administrative matters within the given administration structures
- Develop a sense of initiative and assume responsibility within remedial therapy processes
- Use knowledge of foreign languages in a way which is adequate to the situation
- Demonstrate ethical, economic and ecological awareness within the context of sustainable development

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

State final examination:

1. following completion of training within the scope of the curriculum stipulated at a trade and technical school/ trade and technical academy or
2. following admission as a non-pupil by the education authority of the federal state.

Additional information

Entry requirements: intermediate secondary school leaving certificate or an educational qualification recognised as equivalent and completion of relevant vocational education or training or of training deemed to be equivalent in accordance with the regulations of the federal states

Duration of training: at least 2,400 hours of theoretical training and at least 1,200 hours of practical training

Educational aim: Trade and technical schools/trade and technical academies are institutions which provide continuing vocational training for the assumption of management tasks. Trade and technical schools/trade and technical academies offer a range of organisational forms of teaching (full-time or part-time basis) which lead to a post-secondary state vocational education and training qualification in accordance with federal state law.

Note: in accordance with the regulations of the respective federal state, qualification as a state-recognised remedial therapist takes place via successful completion of the course and, in some circumstances, following successful completion of an accompanying one-year practical placement.
